




Germany's total GDP in 2022: EUR 3,867 bn


NRW – Industrial heartland of Germany

- In 2022, industrial enterprises based in NRW generated sales of **411.1** billion euros.
- The biggest industrial sector in NRW in terms of employment is mechanical engineering with more than 197,000 employees (*19.4 percent share of German total)
- **19.7** percent of the employed population of NRW work in the industrial sector*.
- With the Ruhr Metropolis as its core, NRW is the strongest industrial region in Europe.


Start-Ups in Germany by Federal States



21% growth of new startups in NRW (2023 vs. 2022)





- Cologne/Bonn is Germany's No. 3 air cargo center


Best rail connections

- NRW is an important hub in the high-speed rail network.
- The central station in Cologne is one of Europe's busiest rail junctions.
- 1:15 h from Cologne to Frankfurt by high speed train
- More than 30 high speed (ICE) train stations in NRW



On water to the world ports

- 226 km of the Rhine, one of the world's busiest waterways, flow through NRW
- The state's approx. 120 ports handle 106 million tons of goods by ship
- The world's biggest inland port (Duisburg) and Europe's biggest canal port (Dortmund) are situated right in the center of NRW.
- With a cargo handling volume of 59.0 million tons by ship, train and truck, Duisburg is the most important distribution center in the European canal network
- The Port of Duisburg is one of the most important European mobility hubs in world LCL (less-than-carload) traffic.


